BUGGIES

Any member or visitor with a disability within the meaning of the Disability Discrimination Legislation who is unable to play golf unless aided by the use of a buggy may, use either one of the Club Professionals rental buggies or their own personal four wheeled two seat or three or four wheeled, single seat buggy.

Following a Risk Review, it has been decided that three or four wheeled single seat or four wheeled two seat buggies may be used, but due to the steeper terrain on some holes strict rules on safe usage and safe routes have been defined. Breach of these rules may lead to the suspension or withdrawal of the right to use buggies.

The Club Professional has only a limited number of buggies and any visitor wishing to use one should contact the Club Office or Professional Shop in advance to ensure that one will be available when required. It will be helpful if visitors wishing to use their own buggy also contact the Club at least five days in advance to ensure that all of the requirements can be met.

The Course Manager's daily recorded message on winter course conditions (available on 01935 412122) will now also indicate if the course or a part of the course is not in a suitable condition for use by buggies on that day.

The requirements for the use of a buggy include:

- The production of a medical certificate stating their need under the Disability Discrimination Legislation.
- The holding of and if necessary production of a valid certificate of insurance for third party liabilities if using their own buggy.
- An acceptance of the Club's Health & Safety Policy.

The Club has a very limited facility to store and recharge members' own buggies. Any member or visitor wishing to use their own buggy will therefore need to bring it to and remove it from the course and club premises on each occasion that they wish to use it.

Users of golf buggies do so at their own risk. Yeovil Golf Club Limited has no responsibility for ensuring the safe operation of ride-on buggies on or beyond the confines of the course and the club car-parks other than those operated by their servants or agents. The Club will not accept any liability for any loss or damage to a golf buggy or any other property arising from the negligence of the club, its members, or any of its servants or agents.'
